Senior classes (2nd – 6th) 10.00am – 4.00pm / 5 hours of activities

Activities will include some, or all, of the following and up to 8 activities.

Land (am/pm) Climbing Wall | Archery | Fun Obstacle Course | Dynamic land games

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Please note that we may offer open boating /canoe raft trip, weather permitting. Children wear their own clothes for this activity as they will not need to get wet. If you do not want to avail of this option, you can let us know on the day.

Classes on the junior package participate in land-only activities, but water activities are suitable for ages 6 - 7yrs upwards so they can avail of the Senior tour package by prior arrangement.

WHAT TO BRING

Water Activities (applicable only to children doing water activities)

Swimwear (for under wetsuits), towel, extra pair old runners/shoes for wearing in the water (no flip flops or crocs). **Shoes must be worn at all times *including* during all water activities.**

Land Activities

Waterproof jacket and fleece for variable weather. We recommend long pants, rather than shorts, as they provide extra protection against scuffs and ticks. Change of clothes is recommended in damp weather, particularly extra pair of socks.

General

- Snacks, healthy lunch and drink. **There is a café and tuck shop on site.**
- Any medication you may need i.e. inhaler. Sun cream, hat etc (where appropriate).
- Plastic bag for bringing wet clothing home. ***Please remind your child to check they have all their belongings going home. We can only hold on to lost property for 1 week due to the volume during school tours.***

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- We recommend that phones and electronic items are not brought to their school tour. **NB: We have a strict policy about the use of phones and will *confiscate phones* found to be in use during activities. Phones are totally prohibited in or around the changing areas.**
- **We do not accept responsibility for lost or damaged items and *strongly advise children not to bring/wear expensive clothing, jerseys etc*.**

Wetsuits, buoyancy aids and helmets are provided by us. BUOYANCY AIDS MUST BE WORN WHEN ON OR NEAR THE WATER.

IMPORTANT NOTE: *Prior to participating in our activities, please notify the accompanying teacher of any disabilities, injuries, illness, or allergies that your child may have.*

SCHOOL TOUR

TERMS, CONDITIONS and IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **BOOKING & PAYMENT** A non-refundable deposit is required to secure bookings. In the case where you are unable to attend on the date booked, bookings can be deferred to another date that suits both parties. Bookings are confirmed only when deposits are received within the timeframe indicated in booking correspondence.
- Final expected numbers should be submitted at least 2 days before arrival date. However, in the case where there will be a 10%, or more, drop in the numbers booked and the number attending the tour, please give as much advance notice as possible otherwise we may have to charge for a number of those not in attendance.
- The balance is due on or before the tour date and we accept cheque, cash, card or EFT. If paying by EFT, payment must be made at least one day before arrival.
- **INCLUSION:** We promote an inclusive environment here and, to that end, we welcome children of all abilities and needs. However, it must be noted that we are an outdoor activity centre, with areas of rough terrain, and do not specialise in facilitating participants with spinal disabilities. We do have wheelchair-friendly areas and an accessible toilet. We will facilitate participation for children with additional needs and/or disabilities in as far as possible and with the support of a teacher or SNA.
- Activities cannot be altered or adapted where this change may breach our health and safety protocols. The final decision is made by the senior instructor and manager on duty – no exceptions.
- **SCHEDULE / ACTIVITIES:** We facilitate day tours for several schools each day during May and June so we operate a strict schedule of activities, therefore, **PUNCTUALITY** is crucial to ensure the children get to do all of their scheduled activities.
- Each school will be greeted at their bus on arrival and brought to their own base for gathering, leaving bags, eating etc.
- We do not require a minimum number of students to book a school tour, however, small groups may share **activity** slots. They will still have their own base.
- Shannon River Adventure Ltd. reserves the right to alter programmes at short notice due to inclement weather conditions, non-satisfactory numbers participating etc. In this case we will offer alternative arrangements.
- **RESPONSIBILITY:** All participants must agree to be bound by the safety regulations of the centre and hereby agree:
 - To wear safety clothing, headgear and footwear when required and instructed to do so.
 - To follow all instructions meticulously
- Bookings are accepted on the basis that no responsibility is accepted by Shannon River Adventure Ltd., its proprietors or instructors for any injury, damage or loss to a client's property or person however caused.
